
Kody Technologies LLC Bike Rack Light – Mach2 Installation Instruction

Model#: 101-025

The rack light installs at the back of the rack using either Voile straps or a set of P-Clamps. It fits cleanly and doesn't affect any tray adjustment or bike loading. Tools: 11/32" wrench and a 3/32" allen wrench

1. Raise the rack's clamp arms to make space for the installation. Clean the top tube for ideal pad adhesion. Apply two neoprene pads to the top round bar. Position the pads overlapping each side edge of where the bike tray ends.

Edge of bike tray on each side.



2. Set the light on the pads; centered between the two bike trays.

3. Feed the Voile strap through the rectangular cut out, around the bottom tube and back through the buckle. Pull tight to the 3rd hole and set the buckle.

Permanent Install with P-Clamps

4. Set the two P-Clamp halves into place around the tube and against the bracket. Run the screw through the clamp and install the lock nut. Tighten the hardware until the clamp is fully seated and locked in place.



5. Route cable along length of rack to vehicle connection and use cable ties to secure the cable to the rack frame. Bike racks have many pivot points. Be sure to route the cable away from and around pivots to keep them from getting pinched.



Route cable along rack and test the light.

- 6. Connect the light to your vehicle's trailer connection and test all light functions (tail, brake, hazard, left and right-hand turn signals).
- 7. If turn signals don't function correctly on your vehicle, please see the "How to" page on our website for LED Trailer Lights or contact us.
- 8. Final Step: Install Kody Sticker on bike, bike rack or vehicle. Have fun and be safe!
